Coalition to Prevent Teen Dating Violence Broad Goals

Goal 1: Develop and launch a multi-tiered youth dating and sexual violence prevention effort.

Outcomes:

- Increased awareness and community engagement in the prevention of teen dating and sexual violence.
- Reduction of primary perpetration of teen dating and sexual violence.

Goal 2: Convene and establish a Coalition to Prevent Teen Dating Violence to assess prevalence of teen dating and sexual violence, research and identify culturally competent prevention strategies, and to pilot existing education/prevention programs.

Outcomes:

- A sustained and shared commitment to violence prevention and collective resources to generate change and prevent teen dating violence in the Louisville Metro Area.
- Updated Community Needs Assessment and recommendations for the community.
- A strategic plan to meet identified needs.

Goal 3: Implement prevention programs (i.e. Green Dot) in 6 sites: 2 parochial schools, 2 public schools, and 2 at-risk populations. The program will educate youth, parents, teachers and other supportive figures about dating/ sexual violence as well as tools and behaviors for healthy relationships and effective intervention techniques. It will include objective evaluation and modification.

Outcomes:

- A safer environment at schools/host sites and in the community.
- Increased sense of self-efficacy for participants
- Substantive attitude and behavior change
- Reduction in primary perpetration of violence.
