1. IN LOVE AND IN DANGER: Teen Dating Violence and Sexual Assault

Tuesday, April 13, 2010 / 1-4 pm

Approximately one in four high school aged girls is a victim of dating violence and 40% of high school aged girls know someone who has been. Nearly half of all sexual assault victims, are assaulted before the age of 18. This training will equip those who work with teens to confront this growing problem head-on. Participants will gain understanding into the dynamics of dating violence and sexual assault and learn skills to both pro-actively and re-actively respond to the problem.

2. FINDING THE STRENGTH WITHIN: Understanding and Responding to Sexual Assault

Tuesday, April 20, 2010 / 1-4 pm

One in four women and one in seven men will be a victim of sexual assault in their lifetimes. Often the trauma experienced by survivors of sexual assault intersects with many other areas of need including homelessness, substance use and abuse, child abuse and domestic violence. This training will help providers understand the dynamics of sexual assault and how to respond appropriately to clients who have survived a sexual assault.

3. IT HURTS ME TOO: The Effects of Domestic Violence on Children Exposed

Tuesday, April 27, 2010 / 1-4 pm

Children are always affected when they are exposed to violence in their homes, whether they are physically abused, have witnessed abuse or are coping with the aftermath. This training explores these effects and provides social workers with age-appropriate responding strategies and resource referrals.
